The year 2023 commenced on a wonderful note when the results of our 10th and 12th classes CBSE Board Examination came out. We are happy to share with the details of the commendable performances of our students.

12th class CBSE result was declared on May 12th, 2023 and we are happy to announce that Sivagiri Vidyaniketan Senior Secondary School attained **100% result** .

Total 58 students appeared for Board exam. 50 students got distinction, 8 students got first class, 19 students got above 90%.

ALL Commerce student got distinction.

In class 12th science stream we have 3 full A1 and from commerce 6 full A1.

Aids awareness class was conducted by Sakkeer Sir for class 9 and 11.


Science and Maths clubs joined hands to make students aware of the importance of energy conservation on December 14th as a part of observing energy conservation day.


This report is the sincere attempt to showcase our progress in terms of achievements and activities during the year.
